

Gamble Aware Co-Creation Group

Research shows that, people who are from black, Asian and other ethnic minority communities are less likely to access specialist gambling support and more likely to face barriers in accessing support compared to their white counterparts.

[Gamble Aware](#), a national charity that provides information and support to help people make informed decisions about their gambling, has commissioned [ClearView Research](#) to conduct research to understand more about their experiences of accessing gambling support services for people from black, Asian and other ethnic minority communities who have experience of gambling harms. Gambling harms include negative physical, psychological or financial impacts caused by gambling. These negative impacts could be financial worries, relationship difficulties, or emotional distress.

To understand more about the experiences of people from black, Asian and other ethnic minority communities who have experience of gambling harms, we are working in partnership with [BetKnowMore](#), [YGAM](#), [Red Card](#) and [IPSOS](#) to collect insights about how people from these communities access gambling support services, and what barriers or challenges exist that might make this difficult.

We are looking to recruit 6 people from across the UK who have lived experience of gambling harms to join our co-creation group. As a member of the co-creation group, you will work closely with ClearView to advise us on how we design and conduct our research, as well as offer your own insights into the research findings based on your own experiences.

We really want to hear the voices of people from black, Asian and ethnic minority communities to ensure that their voices are central to the research.

If you are invited to join our co-creation group, you will be paid £350 for your time. An extra £350 will also be donated to a charity of your choice out of four options we will provide to you. As a member of the co-creation group you will be expected to commit up to 15 hours over 4 months.

The co-creation group will be expected to:

- Join a number of online meetings with ClearView, BetKnowMore, YGAM and Ipsos to inform and critically assess the research design and research findings
- Support and advise ClearView on how they design and conduct the research (including the language used)
- Attend a session with ClearView, BetKnowMore, YGAM and Ipsos to discuss and agree on the findings to be included in the report
- Have a genuine interest in the research topic and a passion for supporting others with lived experience of gambling harms

The first session will take place online on Thursday 10th March 6pm - 7pm

The deadline to apply is Monday 7th March. Interviews will take place on Tuesday 8th March and successful participants will be informed on Wednesday 9th March.

There are limited spaces available and we want to ensure that the group includes people who have both direct and indirect lived experiences of gambling harms.

If you are shortlisted for an interview we will arrange a time to hold an online interview on the **8th March** where we can discuss the project aims in more detail. As such, places will be offered to those who fulfil these criteria on a first-come, first-served basis. If you are successful and selected to participate in the co-creation group we will inform you via text, and, or email, and send you further details to join the online meetings.

Any personal information we collect from you:

1) will **NOT** be shared with any other organisation

2) will be kept confidentially and securely in accordance with our GDPR and Data Protection Act responsibilities.
